## Sports Competitions

As you know schools are under increasing financial pressure. This means that we are having to take tougher decisions on how we spend our money and deploy our resources. A major area of expenditure is supporting participation in competitive sports activities and events. Although we receive money from the Government to help support this it does not cover all actual costs. The total cost to the school of taking children to a single sports competition is approx. £250. This includes the cost of buying into the services of the South Shropshire School Sport Partnership - approx. £85 per competition, transport and payment of supervising staff. This is why we need a contribution from parents towards the transport costs.

Children love going to these competitions and Wistanstow always does well. They enable children to participate and shine in a non-academic area of the curriculum. They take pride in their achievements and in representing the school, as the success in the Netball Final this week shows.

Further competitions (see below) are scheduled for this academic year.

We will be asking for a contribution of up to £5 depending of the number of children attending and the cost of the coach/es and we hope that children will be able to attend as many of these events as possible. Should we not receive enough financial support to cover transport costs we, regretfully, will be forced to cancel our participation at an event.

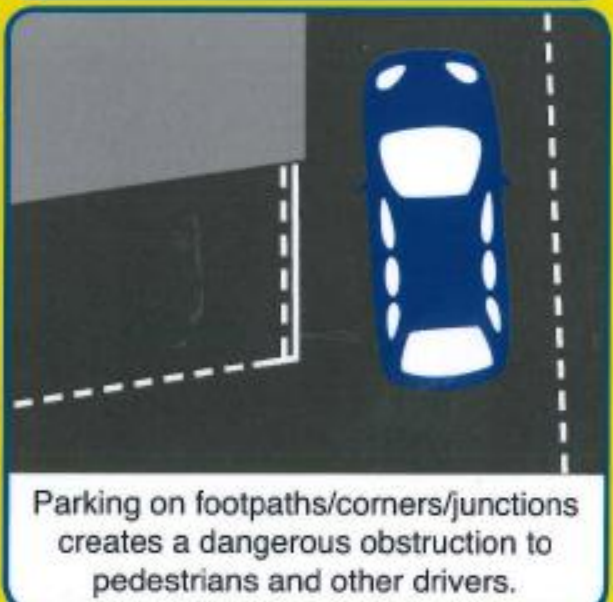
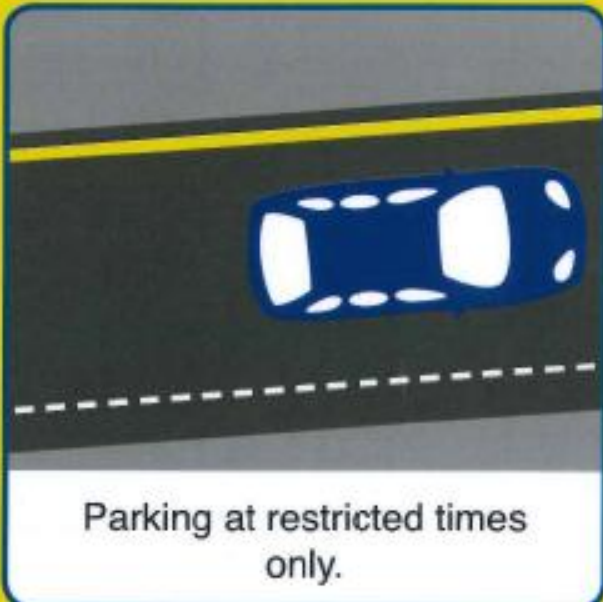
